

## EXHIBITION APPLICATION 2009–2010

PS122 Gallery is a not-for-profit exhibition space dedicated to providing exhibition and support services to emerging artists. Each year we invite artists and curators to apply for two-person or group exhibitions, which are juried by a panel of art professionals including a curator, a writer, an artist and a member of the PS122 Gallery Advisory Board.

PS122 Gallery accepts applications for juried exhibitions from individual artists, 2-person groups or other small groups. **Individual artists are encouraged to apply.** They will be paired with another artist by the jury. Applications from students are not accepted.

Artists selected by the jury will be given the opportunity to exhibit their work for approximately three weeks. They will also receive announcement postcards, press materials and guidance from the gallery director. While there are no geographical eligibility requirements, this opportunity is most appropriate for artists who live within commuting distance because artists are required to install their own exhibition and to gallery-sit on weekends.

**The deadline for receipt of proposals is May 23, 2009.** Proposals may be hand delivered to the gallery Thursday through Sunday, 12–6pm. Proposals may also be mailed by standard US Mail. We do not accept FedEx or special deliveries. No late applications will be considered.

**Applicants will be notified in late August.** Please do not call the gallery regarding the status of your application. If you wish to confirm the receipt of your application, please enclose a self addressed stamped postcard.

**Video and film artists:** We are accepting applications for video and film artwork. Work may be intended for single or multiple channel presentation as installation. PS122 Gallery is currently unable to provide video, film and 3VD equipment for screening at the Gallery. If the work is selected for exhibition it is the artist's responsibility to provide adequate screening and/or installation equipment.

### 2. DIGITAL FILES

**CD:** Submit JPEG files on a CD labeled with the name of the artist. For individual artist and two-person group applications, submit 5 images per artist. For group shows with three or more artists, submit three images per artist. We only accept JPEG files in the following format: Each JPEG image should be no larger than 1024 x 768 in size and 72 dpi in resolution. Each file should be named in the following format: Last name, underscore, first name, underscore and the number corresponding with the work description list e.g. "Lastname\_Firstname\_01.jpg".

**DVD (ONLY video/film artists):** Submit one video no more than 3 minutes in length. The video should be in NTSC format. For video/film artists applying as a group, each artist should submit one video of no more than 3 minutes in length on the same DVD.

**3. WORK DESCRIPTION LIST** Please make sure to include a description of the pieces submitted in your application, numbered to correspond to the jpeg file with the artist name, title, dimensions, medium and year of the work.

**4. RESUME** Enclose one resume per artist. **Do not include any other support materials.**

**5. STATEMENT** You may attach a short text [**under 70 words**] to accompany the slides.

The text is integral to the understanding of my work.

**NOTE:** Your images/video are the most important part of your application. Please make sure they are of reasonable quality, and try to select images that present a coherent visual statement about your work. Your CD or DVD will not be returned, so please do not send your only copy.
